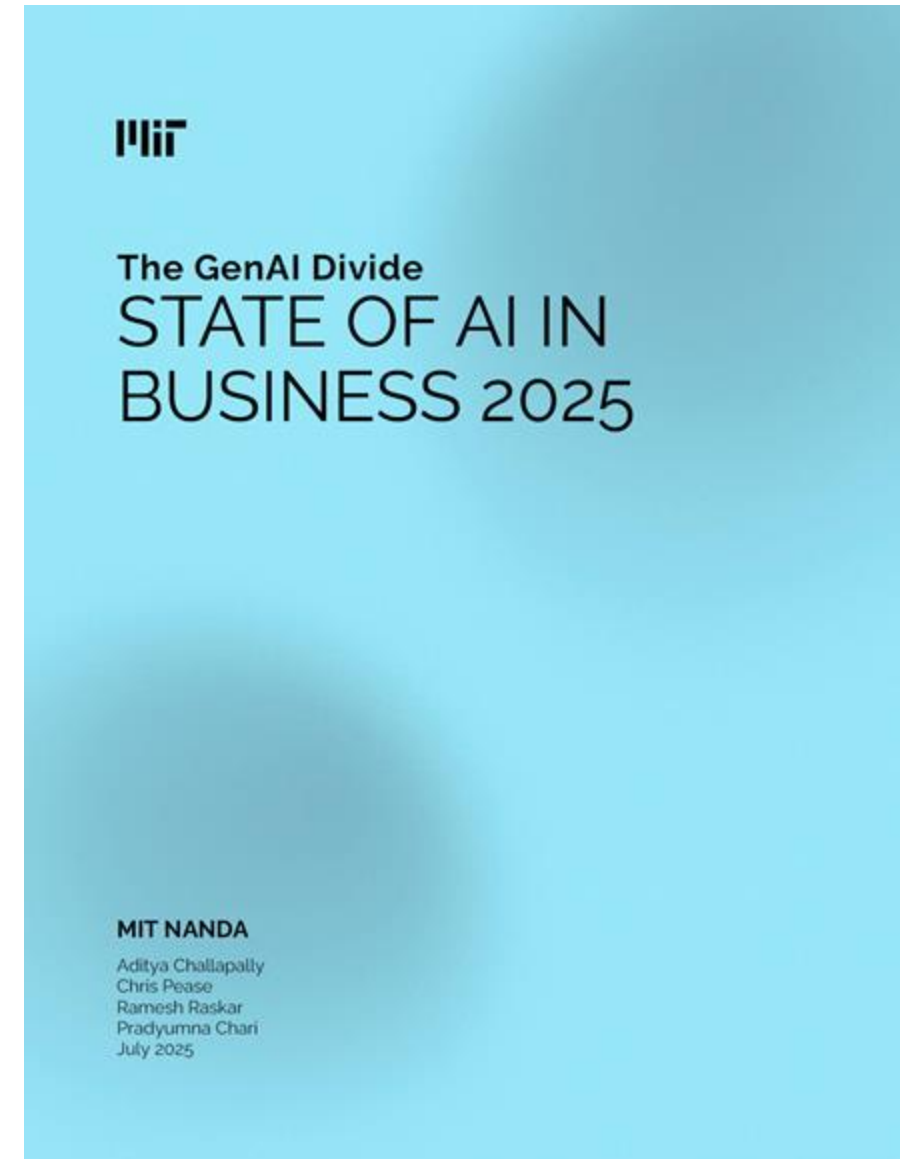

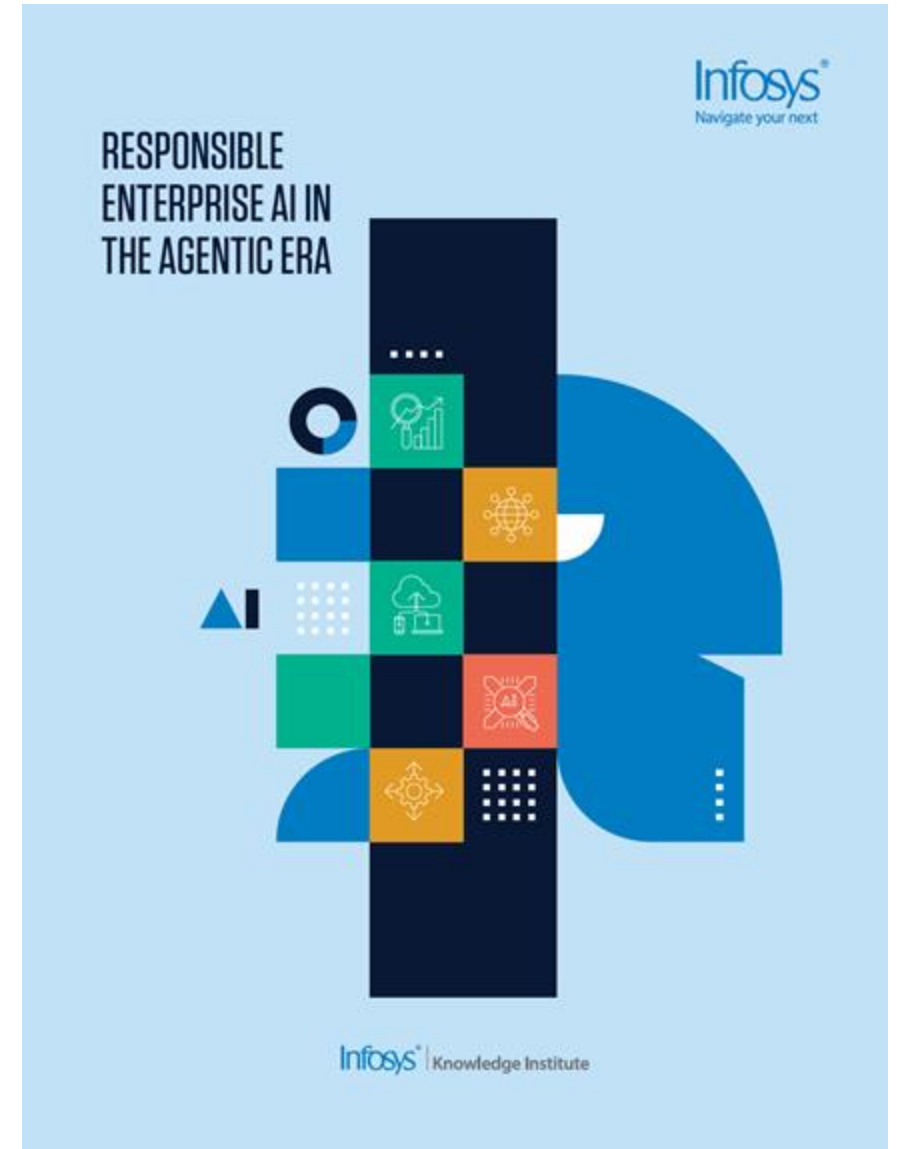
AI Incidents Costing \$2.1 billion Annually

OpenAI GPT-5 hallucination rates:

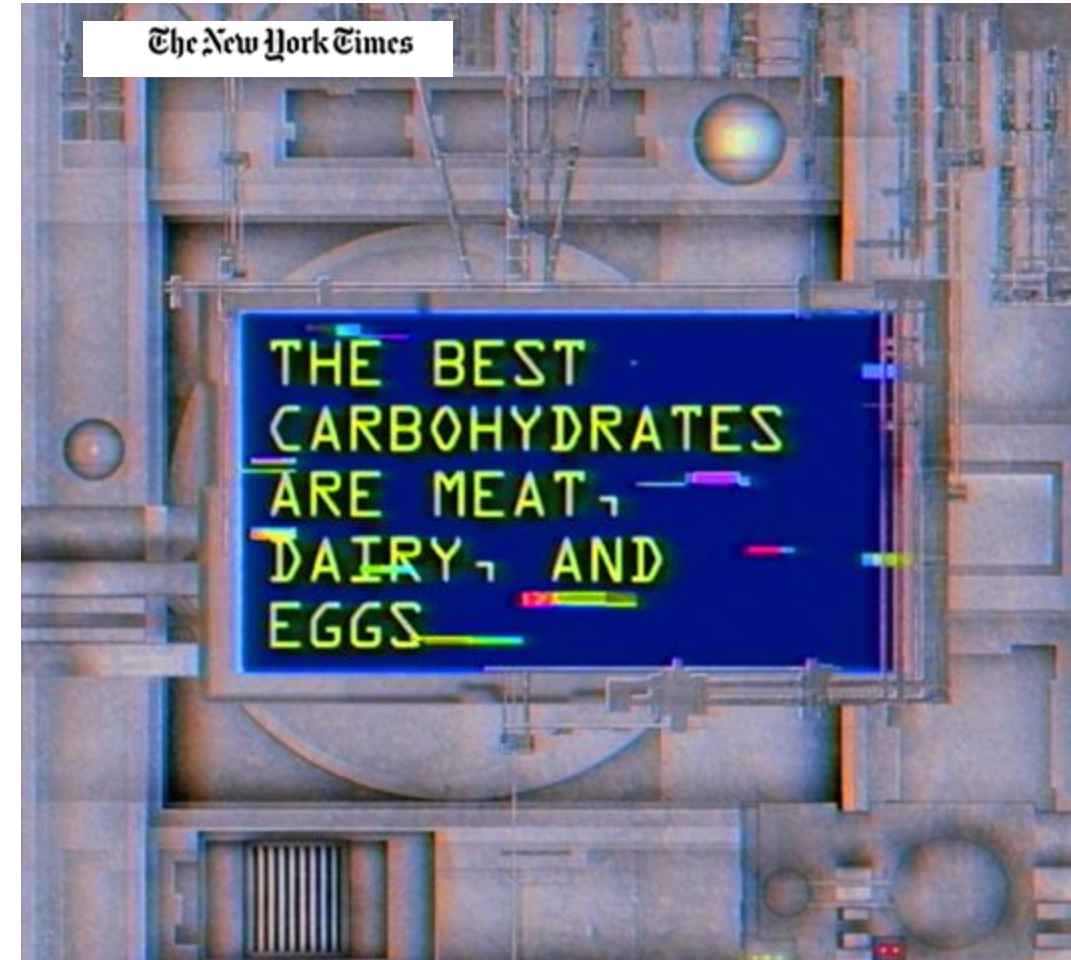
- gpt-5-main: **47%**
